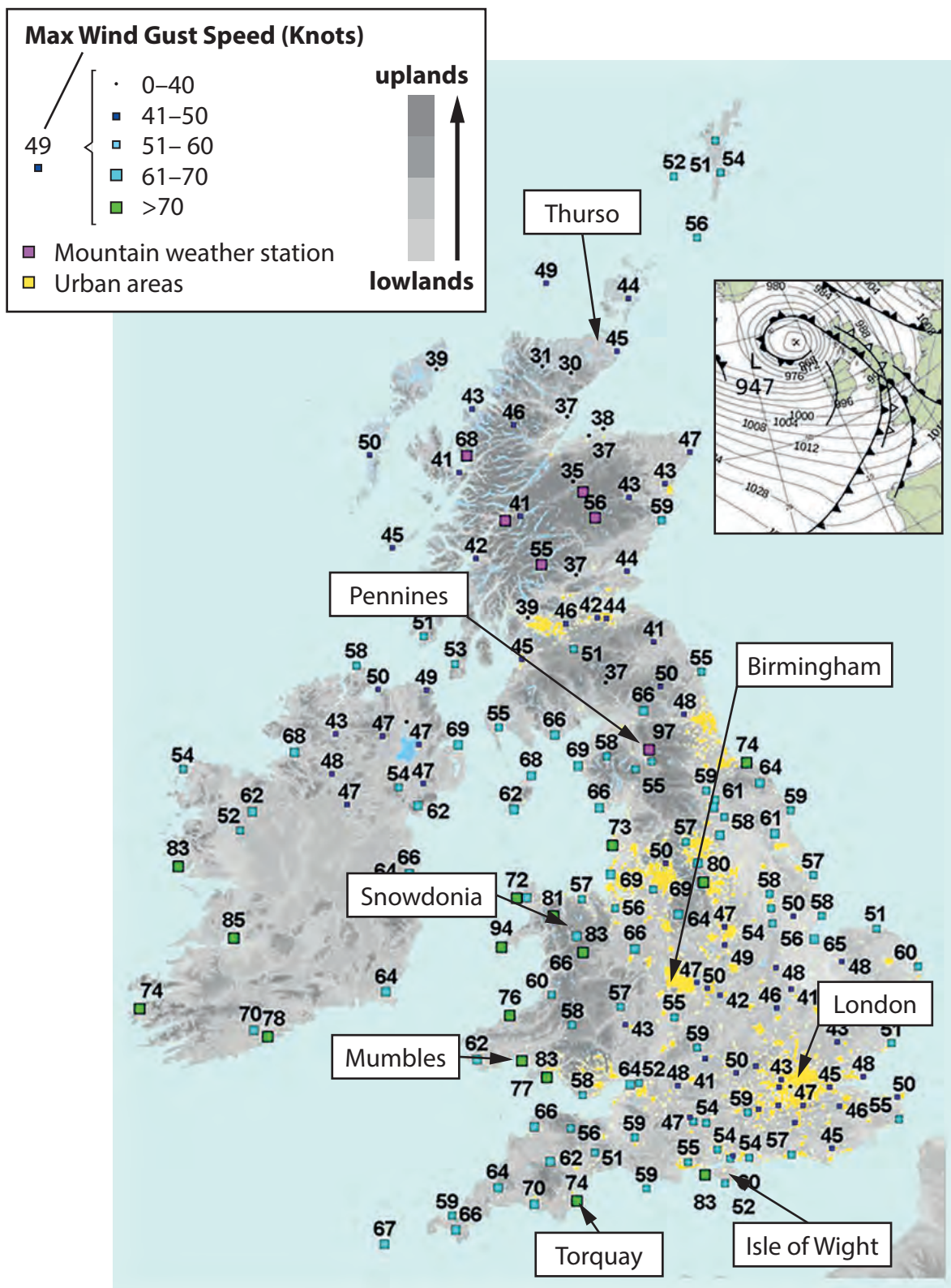
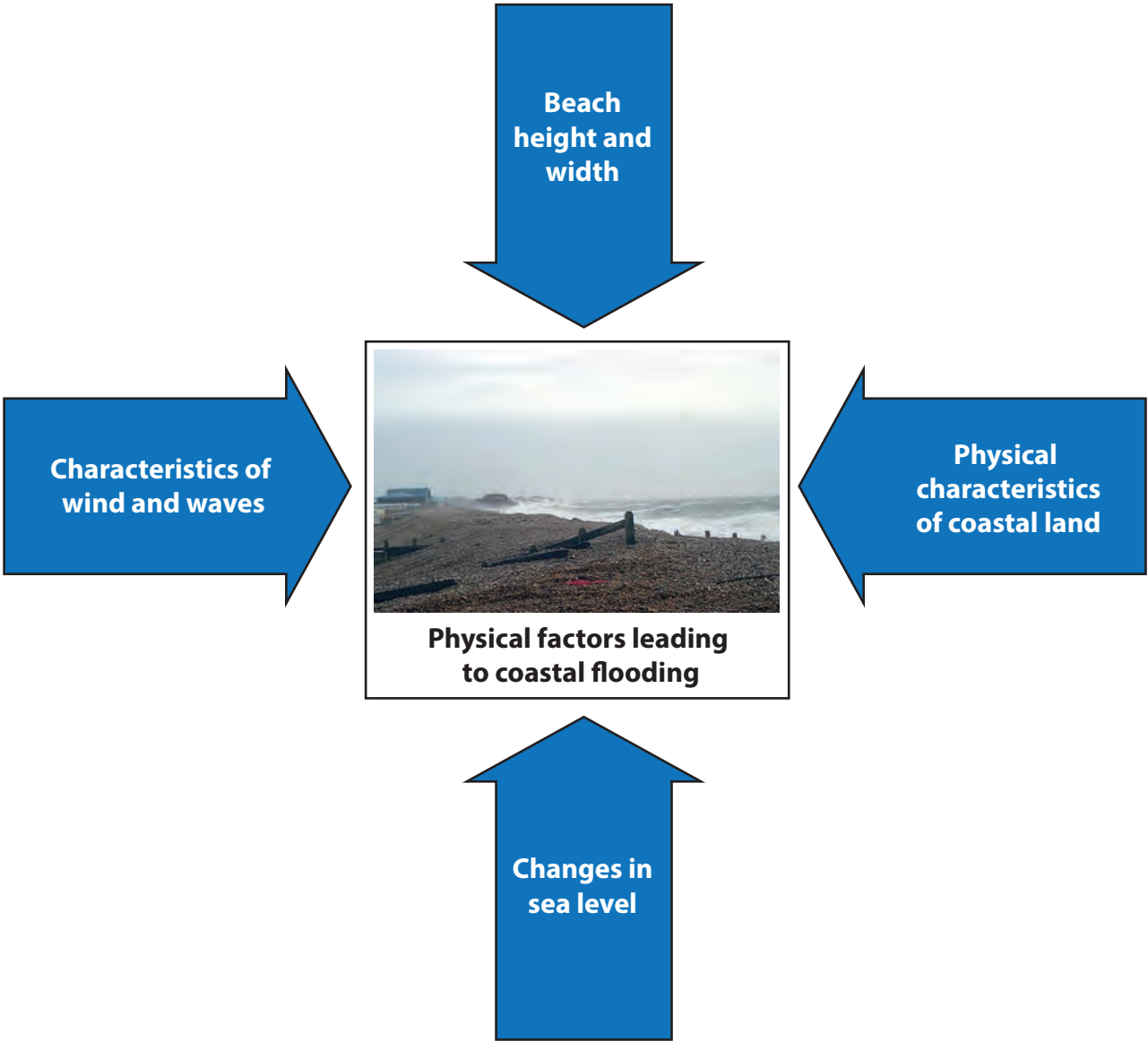
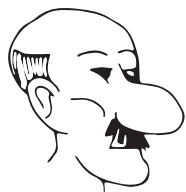

"Even with two of us working, our rent is so high that we can't save enough to buy our own house. It's just not affordable."



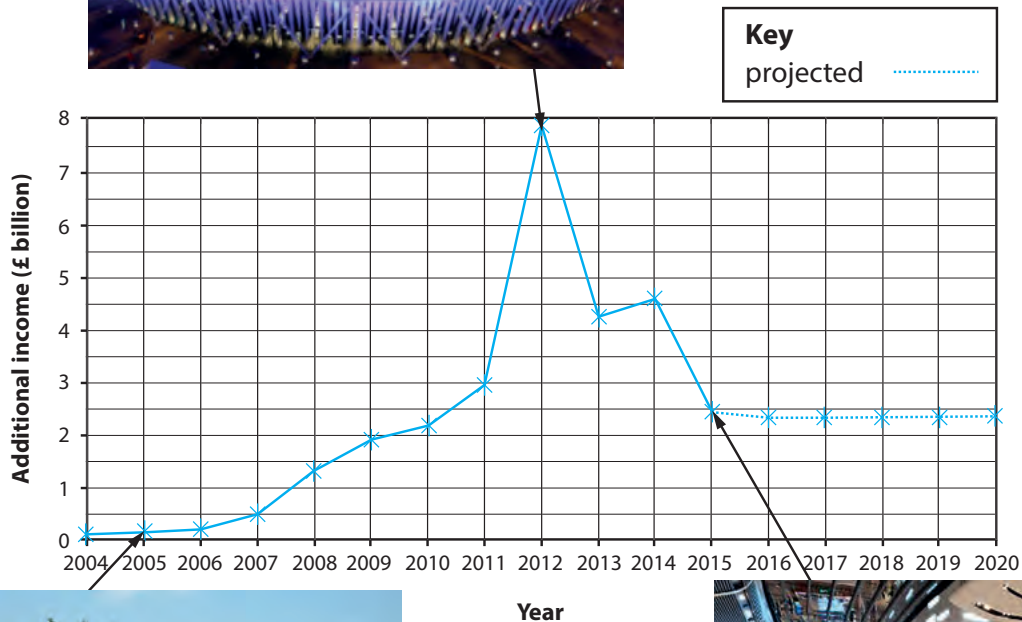
